

Bio for Dr. Sutapa Amornvivat

Sutapa Amornvivat, Ph.D. is the CEO of SCB Abacus, an advanced data analytics company under Siam Commercial Bank, where she previously served as Chief Economist and headed the Economic Intelligence Center (EIC) and the Risk Analytics Division.

Sutapa currently sits on the Subcommittee on Monetary Banking, Financial Institutions and Capital Markets, under the National Legislative Assembly. She is also a member of the General Committee of the Thai Center of Excellence for Life Sciences (TCELS); and a member of the Public Sector Audit and Evaluation Subcommittee overseeing the development of Thailand's Eastern Economic Corridor (EEC), as part the Office of the Public Sector Development Commission (OPDC).

Before SCB, Sutapa founded TMB Analytics at TMB Bank during her secondment from ING Group. Prior to joining the banking industry, Sutapa was an economist at the International Monetary Fund (IMF) in Washington, DC. She also served as Director of Macroeconomic Analysis Section at the Thai Fiscal Policy Office.

Sutapa holds an undergraduate degree in Applied Mathematics from Harvard University and a doctorate degree in Technology, Management, and Policy from Massachusetts Institute of Technology (M.I.T.). She was a recipient of Thailand's prestigious King's Scholarship, and a representative of Thailand in the 23rd International Chemistry Olympiad. In 2007, Sutapa was honored by the Asia Society as Asia21 Young Leader Fellow.
